RE: MTC TIP Revision No. 2019-36 – Amendment

Dear Mr. De Terra:

Please be advised that MTC recently made several changes to the 2019 Federa Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). TIP Revision No. 2019-36 revises 29 projec with a net increase in funding of approximately \$350 million. Among other changes, thi revision:

- Amends two new projects into the TIP and updates six other projects to reflect the recent adoption of the 2020 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) by the California Transportation Commission (CTC);
- Amends the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority's (VTA's) "Not on Transit"
   Program into the TIP to reflect the award of \$350,000 in Federal Transit
   Administration (FTA) Human Trafficking Awareness and Public Safety Initiative
   Grant funds. This program aims to train employees and raise passenger awareness to
   recognize and report human trafficking activities on transit;
- Updates the funding plans of six projects, amends one new project into the TIP and deletes an existing project to reflect changes in the Transit Capital Priorities (TCP) Program;
- Amends four other new exempt, individually-listed projects and one new grouped listing, totaling \$103 million, into the TIP; and
- Archives five projects as they have been completed or all federal funds for the project have been obligated.

The modifications made pursuant to this revision do not require a new regional emissions analysis because the projects were found to conform as a part of a previous analysis, pursuant to the transportation conformity provisions found in 40 CFR Part 93 section 122(g).

MTC's 2019 TIP, as revised with TIP Revision No. 2019-36, remains in conformity with the applicable State Implementation Plan (SIP) for air quality and the revision does not interfere with the timely implementation of the Transportation Control Measures contained in the SIP.

The investments described in MTC's 2019 TIP, as revised with TIP Revision No. 2019-36, make progress toward achieving the performance targets set by the region in accordance with the applicable provisions and requirements of 23 CFR Part 450.
