

Sue Noack was elected to the Pleasant Hill City Council on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 and assumed office on Monday, December 1, 2014. She was Mayor in 2016 and 2021 and was recently elected for her third term. Sue's responsibilities in her City Council role include, Budget Committee, Library Subcommittee, General Plan Advisory Committee, Central Contra Costa Transit Authority, and Transpac (RTPC).
