

## Noelia Corzo Biography

Noelia Corzo (she/her/ella) was appointed to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission in 2026 representing the Board of Supervisors in San Mateo County. Corzo made history as the first Latina and Indigenous person elected to the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors in a county with over 62% people of color. A lifelong resident of San Mateo County, Supervisor Corzo is a mom, daughter of Guatemalan immigrants, and bilingual Spanish speaker.

Prior to serving on the Board of Supervisors, Supervisor Corzo was twice-elected Board Trustee of the San Mateo-Foster City School District. She has worked as a social worker, foster youth advocate, and community organizer. She studied Sociology at Cañada College and San Francisco State University, obtaining her A.A. and B.A. degrees.

Supervisor Corzo also serves on the Board of Directors of the San Mateo County Transportation Authority and previously served on the Executive Board of the Association of Bay Area Governments. Corzo approaches policy from a regional lens with the goal of elevating the needs of the most vulnerable. She is dedicated to supporting a robust, seamless, and sustainable public transit network, building affordable housing at all income levels, and protecting tenants from displacement.
