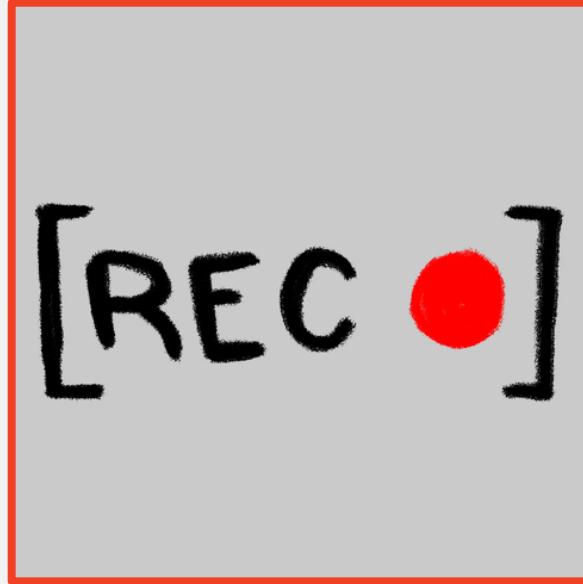

# SS4A Regional Corridor Safety Studies

Phase	Notes	Timeline
1. Identification and study of multi-jurisdictional arterials needing safety improvements.	Likely covered through local LRSPs and VZAPs.	Mostly complete.
2. Planning, design, and project development of quick-build projects.	MTC-led bench of consultants.	MTC's quick build design and engineering services bench is active.
3. Implementation of quick-build projects on selected arterials with analysis of their impact.	Funding contingent on environmental clearance. Funds for construction passed through directly to awardees.	Through 2028-2029.

An opportunity to elevate and implement strategies identified in local LRSPs and VZAPs, focusing on HIN segments covering multiple jurisdictions. ~\$7M in total funding available.
