2026 STATE SB1 COMPETITIVE PROGRAMS

- ❖ SB1 priorities established through prioritization principles adopted by the Commission in April 2026.
- ❖ Regional Policies:
 - MTC's Complete Streets Policy (MTC Resolution No. 4493): Projects must submit a complete street checklist
 - Transit Oriented Communities Policy (MTC Resolution No. 4530): Staff will institute a grace period to January 2027 for transit extension projects to comply with the TOC Policy
 - Plan Bay Area 2050+ Consistency. Conditionally recommended projects must be amended into PBA50+ by May 2027.
- ❖ Additional Condition:
 - BATA/BAIFA Contingency Requirement for Innovate 680 NB Express Lane project
